"The New Revised Standard Version Updated Edition Bible is the result of a commission of the Society of Biblical Literature by the National Council of Churches, which includes dozens of denominations representing 30 million church members. It is both ecumenical and interfaith, suitable in Catholic, Protestant, Orthodox and Jewish contexts. In a period of social and political divisiveness, it's a virtue to be celebrated.

Scholars made clear this was not a new translation. Some of the updated wording is based on new compelling textual evidence, including findings in the Dead Sea Scrolls that were located in the Qumran region of the West Bank.

Over 2 years, 7 general editors and 56 book editors held 76 two-hour meetings about the Hebrew Bible, New Testament and the Apocryphal/ deuterocanonical books, frequently used by Catholic and Orthodox communities, before a final review of their recommendations. The NCC governing board approved the NRSVue in October. The new version [was] released by publishers on May 1, 2022."
