Shenandoah Presbytery met on May 14th at Westminster Presbyterian Church in Waynesboro. Stephany Morgan, as session elected Commissioner, and Pastor Jeff attended. The meeting adjourned before lunch with lunch offered as a time of fellowship and outreach.

Interesting points from the meeting:

- Worship with Communion was a joint effort of Waynesboro Presbyterian Churches, which have come together under the umbrella of 'Better Together'.

- Waynesboro First Presbyterian has sold their facility to Fishburne with the stipulation that the congregation has use of the building for worship, Sunday School, and other events.

- It is required that all churches adopt and implement policies on sexual misconduct, sexual harassment, child and youth protection, and antiracism, as well as boundary training.

- Break out session offered opportunity to learn about a book entitled "Why Presbyterians are Like That".

As a Commissioner, it offered an opportunity for me to learn about other churches in our Presbytery, learn of and participate in actions by the Presbytery that affect us, and obtain resources that may be helpful in our journey.—Stephany Morgan, Commissioner
