

I wonder what we might accomplish in 40 days if we devote it to spiritual well-being.

5.714 weeks...

960 hours...

57,600 minutes...

What might it look like to set aside 5 minutes a day of the 57,600 minutes to praying, reading scripture, or simply being present with God? (How many minutes a day do we spend scrolling on our phones?)

And yes, personal spirituality is important, but Christianity has and always will be a team sport. What might it look like to set aside maybe 5 (let's be generous and say 6) hours of those 960 hours to attending church, to worshiping alongside your friends and family, during those 5.714 weeks?

The new year, it seems, is filled with possibilities. And 40 days feel like an appropriate amount of time to try something new (or new again), especially as it relates to focusing on the health of our spiritual lives. I guess the question for us is: what will we do with the time and opportunities given to us?
